

12. Other flood plain information (identify and describe source) _____

Mahaska Ordinance No. 112 requires the lowest floor (including basement) of any new or substantially improved residential building to be elevated at least 1.0 foot above the 100 year flood elevation. Historical records show both the 1993 and 2008 flood elevations exceed the 100 year flood elevation, with the 1993 flood elevation exceeding the 2008 flood elevation by typically 0.75 foot. While Mahaska County cannot require at this time the lowest floor elevation exceed the 1993 and 2008 flood elevations, elevating the lowest floor (including basement) to 1.0 foot above the 1993 flood elevation is strongly urged.
