The Mahaska County Board of Supervisors met in work session on the above date at 9:00 a.m. in the third floor conference room of the Mahaska County courthouse. Present were the following board members: Chairman – Mark Groenendyk; Vice chairman – Steve Wanders and Member – Steve Parker. Also present were Ed Goemaat, Mike Rodwell, Don VanDonselaar, Jeremiah Selby, Sec Road; Troy Bemis, Maintenance Director and Susan Brown, Mahaska County Auditor.

It was moved by Parker seconded by Wanders to approve agenda for today's meeting. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

Transmission out in one of graders. Consideration being given to doing a complete rebuild (not just transmission) to it versus buying new as this machine is not as old as others in department. Quote for rebuild is \$186,595 compared to new at \$293,000+. Also discussed spring thaw impact on roads following the severity of the winter season.

One of two courthouse boilers has developed leak. Estimate to fix has been secured but would like to check into doing the tube replacement on both as second one will possibly not be far behind.

It was moved by Wanders seconded by Groenendyk to adjourn. All present voted aye. Motion carried.
