

Mahaska County Attorney Vacancy

The Mahaska County Board of Supervisors is taking applications for the position of Mahaska County Attorney which will be vacant as of May 30, 2015. The specific job duties and description is set forth in Section 331.756 of the Code of Iowa.

Person selected for this position must be a registered voter of Mahaska County, be admitted to the practice of law in the courts of this state as provided by law, qualify by taking the oath of office as provided in section 63.10 and give bond as provided in section 64.8.

The board expects to make the appointment June 1, 2015. The appointee will continue until a successor is elected at the next pending county-wide election.

Application forms may be acquired from the office of the Mahaska County Auditor on the first floor of the Mahaska County Courthouse in Oskaloosa, Iowa, between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday or online at www.mahaskacounty.org. Application and resumes must be submitted by delivery to the Mahaska County Auditor's office by Noon on May 22, 2015.

Although the Mahaska County Board of Supervisors intends to fill the vacancy by appointment, the electors of Mahaska County have the right to file a petition requiring that the vacancy be filled by special election.
