Today, the Mahaska County Conservation Board manages over 1,700 acres of the county as eighteen separate areas. The Iowa Heritage Foundation has been extremely helpful during the land acquisition process for many of these years.

The Mahaska County Conservation Board was established in January 1975. The purpose of the Conservation Board is to provide quality parks, recreation, conservation and environmental education opportunities for the public.

The five members of the Conservatin Board are appointed by the Board of Supervisors for five-year terms. They serve without pay, but receive their actual expenses incurred while carrying out their duties. The board meets on the first Thursday of each month at 7:30, public particiation is welcomed.
